Shaw House offer placements to Children & Young People:

- In need of emergency or respite care
- Who require medium/long term placement option
- Of either gender
- Between the ages of 10 & 18 years.
- Who exhibit challenging/mild to moderate offending behaviour.
- With emotional and behavioural disorder
- Exhibiting sexualized behaviour
- With moderate to severe learning difficulties
- Who are experiencing some crisis in their lives, including those with traumatic pasts
- Who have been victims of physical, emotional or sexual abuse and neglect
- From diverse racial, cultural and religious backgrounds
- Who have difficulties conforming to boundaries and expectations, which places them at risk of social exclusion
- Who are asylum seekers
- Who need to be placed together as part of a sibling group
- Who have difficulty engaging in structured education, including those with a Statement of Educational Needs
- With a history of failed placements
- With history of mental health problems

We will provide a home that actively nurtures and cares for young people, affording them the same rights and opportunities as enjoyed by those not "living in care", to enable them to reach their full potential and grow to become responsible adults.
